**SECOND CITY COUNCIL
ORDINANCE NO. 10
SERIES OF 2006**

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE SUBMISSION OF A CONTINGENT PLAN AS AN ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT IN SECURING MAYOR'S PERMIT IN STAGE CONCERTS, SHOWS, OR ANY EVENT TO BE CONDUCTED IN CLOSED BUILDINGS OR AT OPEN SPACES.

WHEREAS, it is declared policy of the city government to promote the welfare and well-being of the general public;

WHEREAS, this ordinance seek to help not only the owners ,the operators, or the organizers of the said event but also to protect the public during screening hours in order to prevent stampede or any accident, whether or not the same is due to a fortuitous event;

WHEREAS, requiring a contingent plan as an additional requirement in securing a Mayor's Permit is a way of promoting public safety in the conduct of stage concerts, shows, or any event in closed buildings or open spaces;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Panlungsod duly assembled in session to enact:

SECTION 1. All owners and or operators of stage concerts, shows or any event to be conducted in closed buildings or at open spaces in Vigan City shall, upon effectivity of this ordinance submit a contingent plan as an additional requirement in securing Mayor's Permit.

SECTION 2. The contingent plan shall include the following:

- a) stand-by ambulance
- b) first aid
- c) crowd control assistance
- d) and other safety measures as determined by the implementing agency

SECTION 3. Any owner and/or operator of a show who shall operate without the contingent plan as required under the provision of this ordinance shall be punished with a fine of not more than P5,000.00 or imprisonment of not more than two (2) months, or both, at the discretion of the court. This is without prejudice to other criminal charges and or civil liability that may arise for any death, injury or damage to property for failure to provide security measures and prevent violence, stampede or accident.

SECTION 4. If the offender is a corporation or a partnership, the penalty provided above shall be imposed upon the President and/or General Manager and Managing Partner, or Organizer of the said event respectively.

SECTION 5. Any official or employee of the city government who shall issue or cause the issuance of a Mayor's Permit to any owner and/or operator of a staging concerts, shows or any event to be conducted in a closed building or in an open space without the required contingent plan as an additional requirement shall suffer the penalties provided for in Section 3 hereof.

SECTION 6. Any ordinances, rules and regulations found to be inconsistent with any of the provision of this ordinance is hereby repealed or amend accordingly.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
